Outdoor training classes •

Mali Rolph of "See Spot Run" is running these group sessions where good behaviour is reinforced. Your dog will thrive on having your undivided attention and the opportunity to be rewarded for learning the game. Do you avoid a walk because your dog is uncooperative? Are you concerned your dog may jump up on guests? Do you resist letting your dog off leash in case they won't come back when called? Is your dog anxious or noisy when left alone? Learn and then enjoy improved communication with your dog! Mutual rewards, trust, happiness and confidence will follow. The classes are held in fine weather so you may choose to "Like" us on facebook for weather checks. Arrive early to run off steam before the 9.30am, one hour class. Bring a hat, a fixed (non-retractable) leash, solid shoes, toys, treats and \$25.

Muggy weather •

Holy rising damp! It's been so wet that we have seen a spike in skin issues. If your pet is itchy or red, they may need anti-histamines or antibiotics from James. Painful ear infections are also rife, so watch for pets shaking their heads or pawing at their ears or faces.

Fleas and ticks •

There are more fleas around now than there were in summer! So it's even more important to use a monthly topspot squirt throughout autumn and winter to prevent springtime flea infestations. There's also the monthly tablet "Comfortis" which really helps with fleas on dogs.
